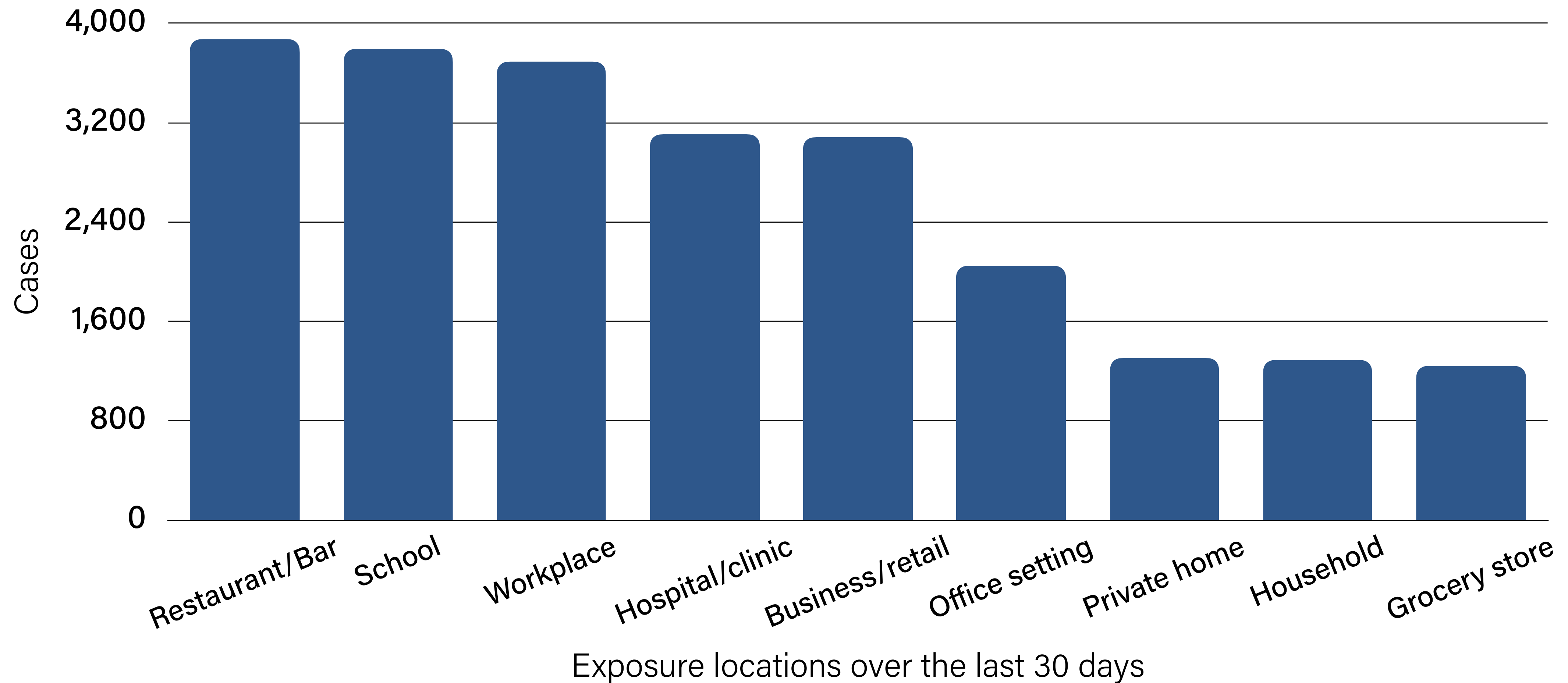

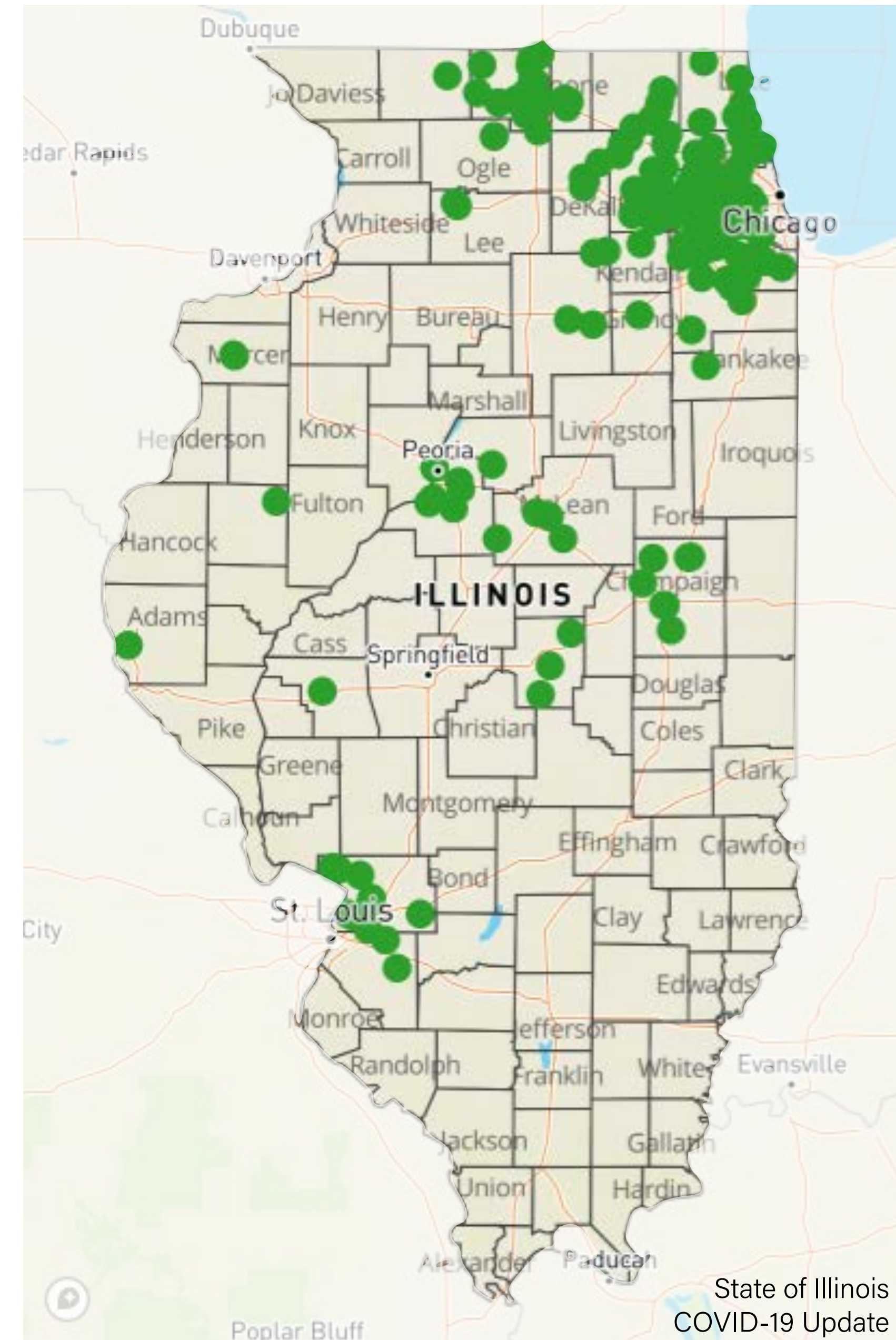

BARS & RESTAURANTS REMAIN TOP POTENTIAL EXPOSURE LOCATIONS



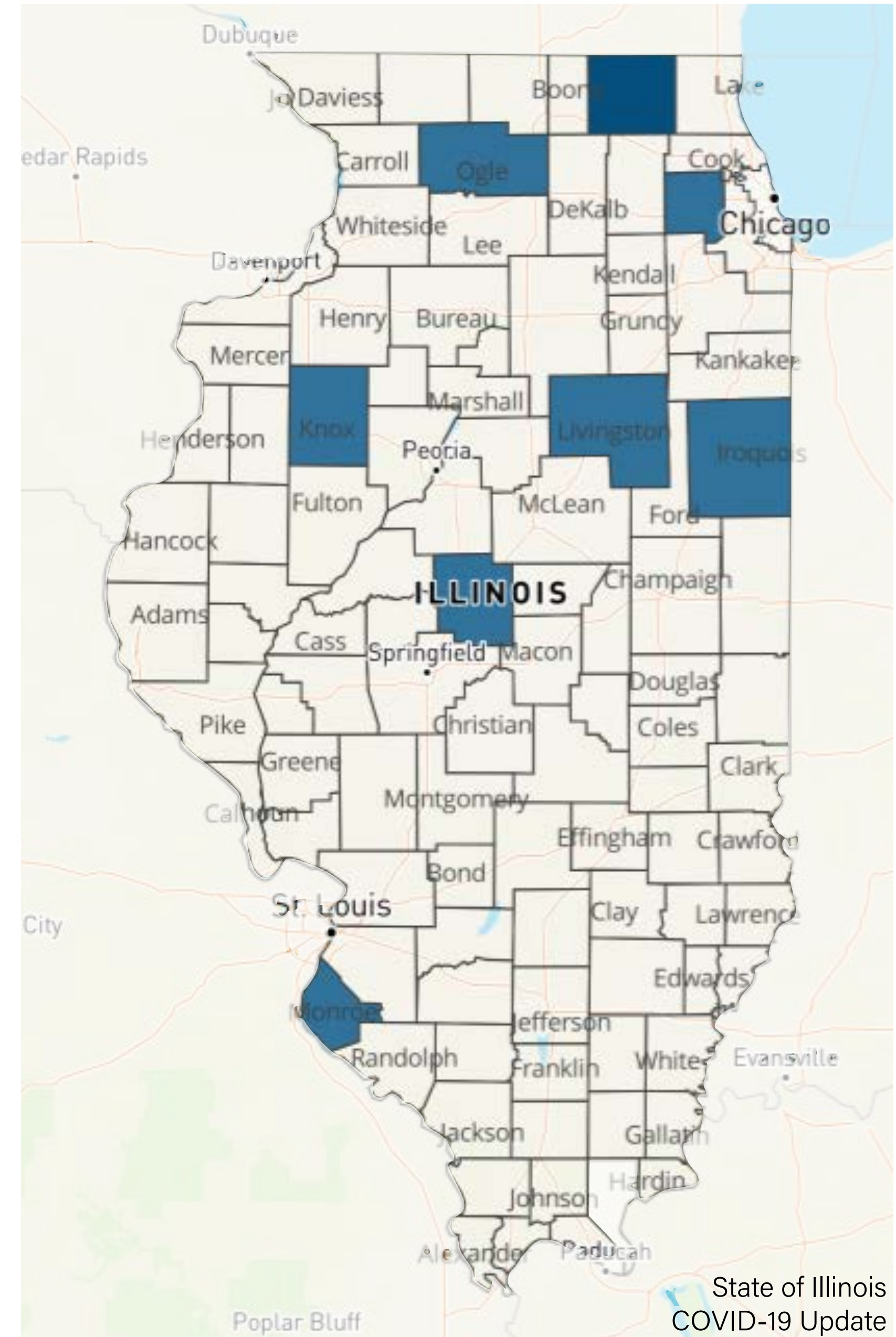

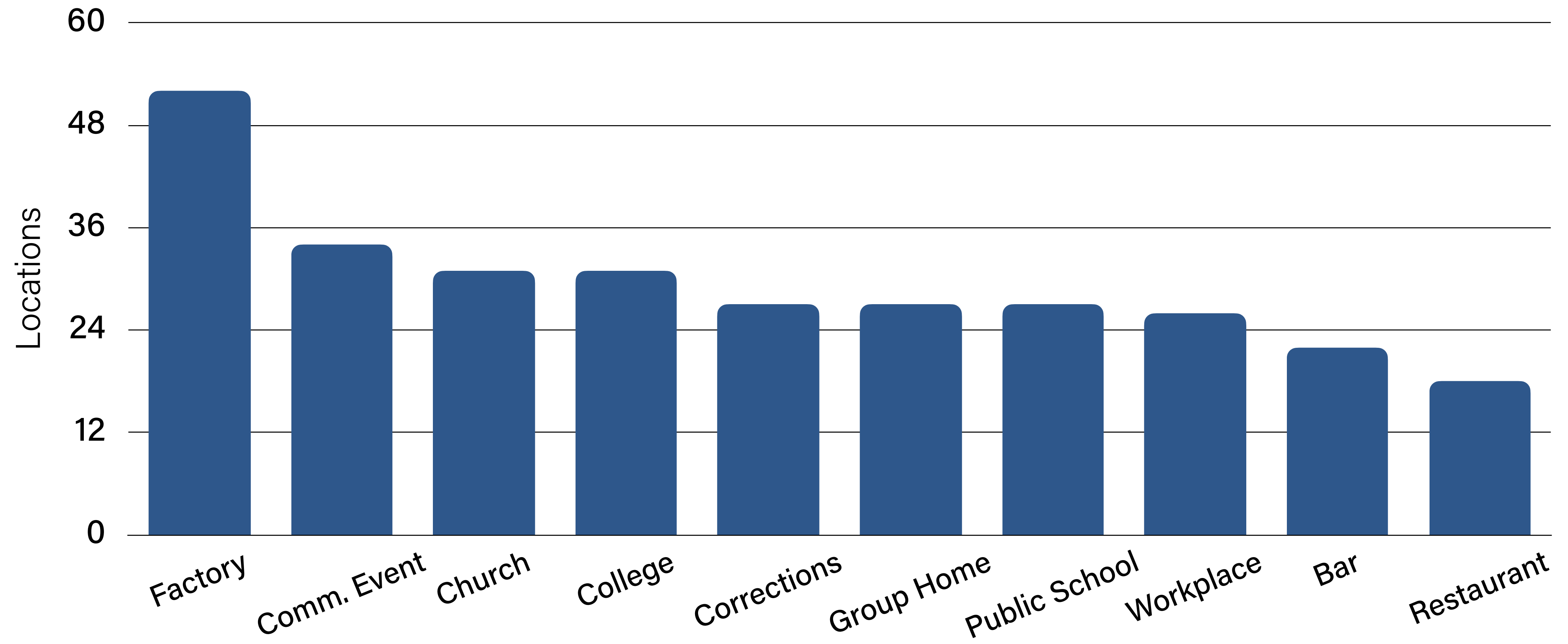

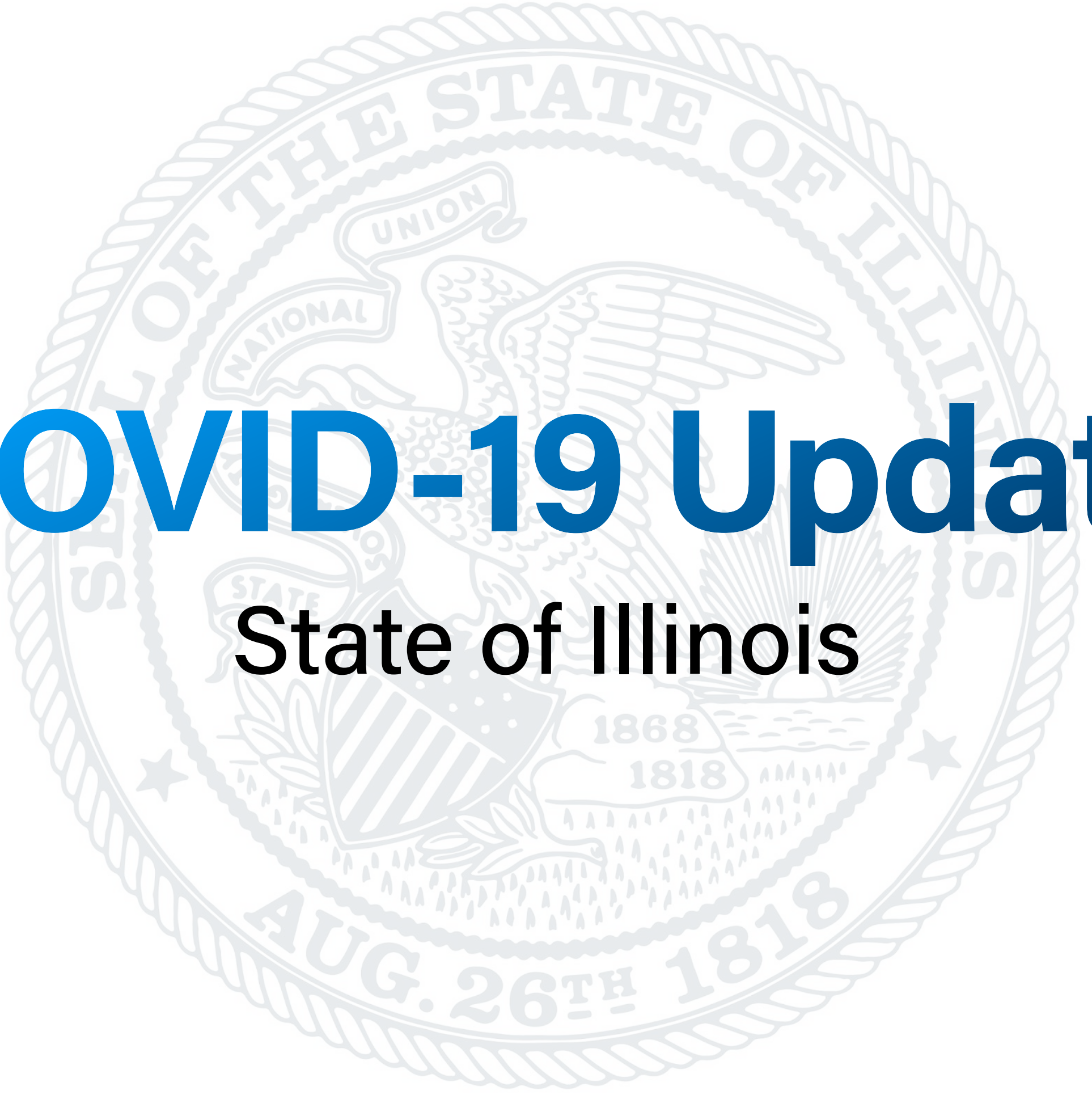
