**MEETING MINUTES**

- Chairman Mattingly called the meeting to order at 9:05 p.m.
- Chairman Mattingly read role call for the council. She noted that there is still a vacant home builder's position on the council. A recommendation has been made which is Jason Huelsmann. We are waiting on final approval of his appointment. In the meantime Jason will participate as a non-voting member.
- Chairman Mattingly asked for introductions of guests.
- Mr. Selway gave an update of DCEO's training efforts and technical assistance. He also stated that Mr. Meyers will be DCEO's code trainer and technical assistance interpretation person again this program year. Mr. Meyers is initially concentrating on the Chicago area to help them role out their program. His first training was Oct. 29 in Chicago. Chicago has amended the code to make it more stringent.
- Dates for future training will be available on the DCEO website soon. 2012 IECC books will be given out with all code training.
- Mr. Selway also spoke of the utilities program which will assist with state wide code compliance.
- Chairman Mattingly gave an overview of established subcommittees, both residential and commercial. Mr. Ayers would like to be on both subcommittees. Each subcommittee should elect a chairperson and also if possible have someone taking meeting minutes. CDB will help coordinate calls and set up meeting times.
- It was decided that teleconferences would work for subcommittee meetings, but that Mr. Ayers and BLDD have videoconference capabilities if needed. Chairman Mattingly will send out polls to establish dates for the first subcommittee

meetings. Mr. Ayers made a motion that at the end of subcommittee meetings, as a minimum, the subcommittee allows not more than 5 minutes of public comment per guest. This will not prevent the subcommittee from engaging guests in the discussion as needed during the meeting. Mr. Selway seconded. Motion carried.

- Chairman Mattingly asked if all council members have received their copy of the 2015 IECC which was mailed out last week. Everyone said that they had.
- Mr. Wytmar asked whether we should re-review the amendments of the 2012 IECC. Mr. Ayers suggested that this should be done by the subcommittees.
- Mr. Ayers asked if there was a compiled list of the significant changes between the 2012 IECC and 2015 IECC. Mr. Selway is going to check with Mr. Meyers to see if he has prepared a document which can be shared.
- Mr. Ayers brought forth the issue of non-enforcement by local jurisdictions. This makes it difficult for the municipalities and counties that are enforcing. Mr. Ayers stated that Iowa is adopting the 2015 IECC. He will report back on any amendments they make. Iowa will be regulating the contractors at the state level. Mr. Huelsmann mentioned that in the metro east area, there are code officials openly stating that they are not enforcing the Code nor do they intend to enforce the code.
- Mr. Meek motioned for adjournment. Mr. Selway seconded. No nays were heard. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
