- Chairman Mattingly called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.
- Chairman Mattingly took roll call.
- Chairman Mattingly opened discussion of the meeting minutes from October 5, 2010. Chairman Mattingly called for a vote. Darren Meyers stated that he wanted to add an agenda item of a personal note. Mr. Meyers stated that he was tendering his resignation to the Council effective immediately. His employment with the International Code Council (ICC) ended on March 25, 2011. His role on the Energy Code Advisory Council was representing Building Officials, therefore he would no longer be able to serve on the Energy Code Advisory Council.
- Mr. Meyers stated that the Council could address him from the gallery and he would be happy to present his report on the 2012 IECC from the gallery.
- Chairman Mattingly thanked Mr. Meyers for his years of service and stated that the Council would welcome Mr. Meyers to sit in the gallery as he sees fit and provide technical expertise as needed. Chairman Mattingly also stated the Council would appreciate hearing his report on the 2012 IECC.
- Chairman Mattingly reminded the Council that their positions are appointed by the Executive Director of CDB. Chairman Mattingly will speak with Director

Underwood about a replacement for Mr. Meyers, who represented the local code officials.

- Chairman Mattingly opened discussion again of the meeting minutes from October 5, 2010. Chairman Mattingly called for a vote. Bruce Selway motioned for approval. John Meek seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Mr. Selway gave an update on the training that is being offered by DCEO. Training is on the 2009 IECC.
- Chairman Mattingly noted she had received an agenda item from Mr. E. Butch Ehrke of the CED Department of the City of Des Plaines regarding temporary structures and enforcement. Mr. Ehrke had a conflict and was unable to attend the Council meeting. However, Chairman Mattingly wanted to raise the issue. Mr. Plass and Mr. Meyers both gave comments on temporary structures.
- After discussion, Chairman Mattingly stated that the Council would most likely need to make an interpretation of the issue to clarify temporary structures. It was decided that the Council can only provide guidance in relation to the code; it can not enforce or issue any type of waiver. It was decided to table this issue to the next meeting in order to hear from code officials.
- Chairman Mattingly stated she will contact ICC to get an interpretation on temporary structures.
- Mr. Meyers gave an update of the 2012 IECC.
- There was discussion of why Illinois is requiring compliance to the code and other states do not. Chairman Mattingly and/or Mr. Selway will contact DOE for information on other state's compliance. Chairman Mattingly stated she was not aware that other states were not complying. Mr. Selway stated that he has spoken with other states that do not enforce this federal mandate. Chairman Mattingly reminded the group that this is also a state law.
- Mr. Selway stated that training of the 2009 is on-going and DCEO are mentioning during the training that training of the 2012 will be scheduled in the future once the details are worked out.
- The Council stated the next meeting should be three in months. Chairman Mattingly will reserve the conference rooms and allow for video conferencing if anyone would want to video conference.
- A motion was made by Mr. Selway and seconded by Mr. Schieler to adjourn. Chairman Mattingly called for a vote, which was approved unanimously. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 3:37 p.m.
