- Chairman Mattingly called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.
- Chairman Mattingly took roll call. Chairman Mattingly noted that Terry Phelan from CDB has resigned from the Council. His replacement will be named through CDB's Executive Director in the future.
- Chairman Mattingly opened discussion of the meeting minutes from September 20, 2011. Chairman Mattingly called for a vote. Don Plass motioned for approval. John Meek seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Chairman Mattingly asked for an update from DCEO. Bruce Selway stated the code education grant has been approved and training will be provided over the next year on the new and existing codes including in Chicago and other "big box stores". In the training there will be a look back to the 2009 as well as training on the 2012.
- Chairman Mattingly went over what handouts had been sent to the Council prior to the meeting and the handouts that were available at the meeting.

- Chairman Mattingly stated the Cost Benefit Analysis of the 2009 IECC vs. the 2012 IECC publication just came the day of the meeting. She asked that everyone review it and if there are questions regarding the report; please send them to her, so that the Council will know any questions and answers that arise. Chairman Mattingly will forward questions on to the appropriate person.
- Chairman Mattingly stated there had been discussion by the Council that if there were revisions to the act what the process would be. Chairman Mattingly spoke with CDB's legislative liaison and he stated that they would not take place in the veto session. Chairman Mattingly stated the law requires the most current version of the code be adopted within 9 months from its publication date (June 30, 2011).
- Chairman Mattingly reminded the Council that once Council approves, it goes to the Capital Development Board, then JCAR and lastly the Governor's office. There are time frames for each step, so everyone needs to keep in mind this is a process that will take a while.
- The Council discussed proposed revisions to the Definitions Section of the code.
- A motion by John Meek was made to approve the Definitions Section including changes. Don Plass seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- The Council discussed proposed revisions to the code.
- There was a motion by Don Plass and seconded by Ray Boosinger to strike 600.200 D. The motion carried.
- There was a motion by John Goetz and seconded by Bruce Selway for 600.300 A to change the date from 2009 to 2012. The motion carried.
- There was a motion by Tom Ayers and seconded by John Goetz for striking everything in 600.305 and tabled discussion on 109.1 and 109.3. The motion carried.
- There was a motion by Tom Ayers and seconded by Ted Schieler in 600.400 Section A – changing the date from 2009 to 2012 and striking everything under 600.405 except for D, E and mislabeled A. The motion carried.
- The next meeting will be set to take place in the next 2 – 3 weeks.
- John Goetz motioned to adjourn. Ted Schieler seconded. The meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
