 - PIPP will check pledges received per month for all vendors (primary and secondary) against the individual maximum monthly limit of \$50, \$100, or \$150 depending on the vendor type selected for the primary and secondary vendors. If the pledge is found to be over the monthly limit for this vendor, PIPP will reject the pledge. The same process will be done to check annual limit for all vendors against the individual maximum annual benefit limit.
