Business Interruption Grants – Severely Impacted Disproportionately Impacted Areas (DIAs)

The Business Interruption Grant (BIG) program is a \$636 million program to provide grants and other financial support to small businesses in Illinois experiencing closure or significant disruption to their business due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over 30 percent of BIG funds must go to businesses located in disproportionately impacted areas (DIAs), which are low-income zip codes that have had a significant number of cases of COVID-19 among residents. For a portion of BIG grants, DCEO will be prioritizing awards to businesses located in "Severely Impacted DIAs," which are zip codes that qualify as DIAs that have also experienced property damage as a result of civil unrest during protest and demonstrations on or after May 25th, 2020. Those zip codes are listed below.
