_____ If no is marked, indicate the date the foster parent or relative caregiver replaced
Date the battery. (Five business days after inspection)

Foster Parent or relative caregiver knows or has been instructed on how to check the smoke detector and applicable carbon monoxide detectors and has been advised to check all detectors batteries monthly.
