Application Process

To apply, send an email to DCFS.internships@illinois.gov and provide the following information:

• Cover Letter

Please make sure your cover letter includes the following:

- Year in school
- Degree status
- Reason for requesting a shadowing experience

• Resume

• Two professional letters of recommendation

Eligible candidates will receive an application packet and information about the next steps in the application process, which includes a background check.
