Safety Assessment Family Evaluation (SAFE) Model

The Action for Child Protection was founded in 1984 and is currently in Phoenix, Arizona. Headquarter is in Charlotte, North Carolina. Action for Child Protection created the SAFE Model. Theresa Costello conducted a presentation in this meeting regarding the Safety Assessment Family Evaluation (SAFE) Model. Theresa reported that 25 plus states use the SAFE Model. Some states use only part of the model while others use the full model. This model replaces CERAP. The goal is to build caretaker protective capacities and quicker reunifications when possible. There are foundational principles and definitions. Items include present danger, caregiver protective capacities and impending danger. Through-out the life of the case, children are assessed as safe or unsafe. We must ensure children continue to stay safe.
