
VIDEO PLATFORM PARENTING CLASSES

- ▶ Given the current state a video platform class offers a safer solution for both participants and Family Advocate workers
- ▶ Offers flexibility on both participants and Family Advocate workers
- ▶ We will reach out to parents during intake process and set up a plan of action by establishing what lines of communication are available for them.
- ▶ We are now able to accept referrals that are out of our service area
- ▶ We encourage parents to email or text if they are feeling nervous or cannot verbalize their emotions.

VIRTUAL PARENT COACHING

- ▶ Initial contact to assess the areas of needs and strengths
 - ▶ Setting up equipment
 - ▶ Age Appropriate Parent and Child activities is based on the parent's areas of interest
 - ▶ We debrief after the visit and discuss areas of strengths and needs
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WHEN THINGS DON'T GO RIGHT

- ▶ Power goes off
 - ▶ Switch devises, or reschedule
 - ▶ Always remind parents to keep calm and to keep their focus on their children.
 - ▶ Identifying areas in the house that offers privacy and comfort for parents to take full advantage of parenting classes.
 - ▶ Meet children
