Plain Language Explanation:

Pursuant to Section 3-106(l)(1)(c)(iii) of the Illinois Human Rights Act [775 ILCS 5/3-106(l)(1)(c)(iii)], the Department is required to promulgate regulations regarding housing for older persons, including verification of occupancy and examples of policies and procedures. The adopted amendments provide guidance to housing providers seeking exemption from the Human Rights Act's familial status discrimination provisions, in accordance with the equivalent federal regulations. 24 CFR §100.306 and 100.307.
