## ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from June 16 to July 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1911867—This project proposes to expose and repair plumbing associated with the pool. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-12-2019.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1911774—This project involves repairs to a water line near the Class A campground. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-11-2019.

- **Coffeen Lake State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1911835—This project proposes to install new electric service towers. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-12-2019.

- **Ten Mile Creek State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1912034—This project proposes bank protection and stabilization on a tributary to Big Creek. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-18-2019.

- **Lake Le Aqua Na State Park**

1910875—This project involves full repair and replacement of its park road system, de-watering and fish kill, dam repair, boat ramp repair, and other related projects for road and lake repairs. Project was originally submitted for review on 5-13-2019.

- **Fort Massac State Park**

1911916—This project will resurface the existing RV campground roadways and campsites. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-13-2019.

- **Grant's Home Historic Site**

1912242—This project involves repair of a water line. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-21-2019.

- **Pyramid State Park**

1910461(2)—These projects involve the earthmoving work for wetland creation at the park. Project was originally submitted for review on 5-03-2019.

- **Rock Cut State Park**

1811749—This project involves bridge construction and trail realignment between Hart Rd and Harlem Rd. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-07-2018.

- **Kickapoo State Park**

1912427—This project is for the construction of new masonry vault toilets at Kickapoo State Park. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-27-2019.

- **Middle Fork State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1408897—This project is for the replacement of vault toilets in the equestrian campground. Project was originally submitted for review on 2-27-2014.

- **Illinois Beach State Park**

2000090—This project proposes to stabilize rapidly eroding beach and bike trails within the north unit. Project was originally submitted for review on 7-02-2019.

- **Peabody River King State Fish & Wildlife Area**

2000376—This project proposes to construct a new picnic shelter in the Day Use Area next to Beaver Lake at Peabody River King State Fish & Wildlife Area. Project was originally submitted for review on 7-09-2019.

- **Peabody River King State Fish & Wildlife Area**

2000378—This project proposes to construct a new picnic shelter in the Day Use Area next to Mink Lake at Peabody River King State Fish & Wildlife Area. Project

was originally submitted for review on 7-09-2019.

- **Fort Massac State Park**

1707670—This project proposes to replace a vehicle bridge at Massac Creek. Project was originally submitted for review on 2-27-2017.

- **Kickapoo State Park**

1912398—This project proposes to remove the remnants of the old burnt down clubhouse. Project was originally submitted for review on 6-26-2019.

2000438—This project proposes to re-route a severely eroded equestrian and hiking trail. Project was originally submitted for review on 7-11-2019.
