

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from October 15 to November 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All of these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Stephen A. Forbes State Park**

1703636 - This project involves installation of an IDNR standard playground at the Black Oak Picnic Area. Project was submitted for review on 10-13-16.

- **Rock Island State Trail**

1703699 - This project involves construction of two arbors, as rest areas, along the existing bike trail within the Alta Access area. Project was submitted for review on 10-17-16.

- **Lowden State Park**

1703648 - This project involves removing above ground utility poles and installation of underground electric service. Project was submitted for review on 10-13-16.

- **Horseshoe Lake State Fish & Wildlife Area (Alexander)**

1703676 - This project involves restoration of a drainage swale adjoining the west side of Oakwood Road to the pre-existing conditions. Project was submitted for review on 10-17-16.

- **Channahon State Park**

1703674 - This project involves replacement of the roof on a pole storage building. Project was submitted for review on 10-17-16.

- **Channahon State Park**

1703675 - This project involves replacement of the roof on a pit toilet building. Project was submitted for review on 10-17-16.

- **Fort Massac State Park**

1704015 - This project involves installation of two wayside exhibit structures and a new entrance sign. Project was submitted for review on 10-27-16.

- **Washington County State Recreation Area**

1704148 - This project involves replacing the floating docks, walkways, and piers as needed. Project was submitted for review on 11-3-16.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1702304 - This project involves re-grading the Equestrian Concession Corral. Project was submitted for review on 8-29-16.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1511751 - This project involves rehabilitating and adding an additional dump station to the existing facility located north of the existing Class A Campground. Project was submitted for review on 4-27-15.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

1704152 - This project involves removal of the Check-in structure at the Illini Campground entrance road. Project was submitted for review on 11-3-16.
