## ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from October 16 to November 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Burning Star State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2004136—This project will demolish a one story office addition at the Burning Star Headquarters. Project originally submitted for review on 11-12-2019.

- **Washington County state Recreation Area**

2003954—This project proposes to remove and replace block privy roofs. Project originally submitted for review on 11-01-2019.

- **Giant City State Park**

2004139—This project proposes to add a privacy fence and carport. Project originally submitted for review on 11-12-2019.

- **Johnson Sauk Trail State Park**

2004086—This project proposes to replace posts and memorial benches. Project originally submitted for review on 11-08-2019.

- **Blackhawk State Park**

1811378—This project proposes to install a new set of trail stairs from the Halberg Museum to the upper trail. Project originally submitted for review on 5-29-2018.

- **Cave in Rock State Park**

2003969—This project was to replace a section of county watermain at the park. Project originally submitted for review on 11-04-2019.

- **Horseshoe Lake State Fish & Wildlife Area**

2003293—This project proposes to construct a levee for water retention for waterfowl and breeding IL Chorus Frog habitat. Project originally submitted for review on 10-01-2019.

- **Randolph County Conservation Area**

2003927—This project proposes to abandon in place an old septic tank and to install a new one. Project originally submitted for review on 10-31-2019.

- **Sam Parr State Fish & Wildlife Area**

2003831—This project proposes to replace 13 yard hydrants throughout Sam Parr. Project originally submitted for review on 10-28-2019.

- **Rose Hotel**

2003760—This project was to review proposed repairs to the Veranda structure and supports. Project originally submitted for review on 10-23-2019.

- **Illinois Beach State Park**

2003581—This purpose of this review is to have environmental clearance to be able to respond to hydrologic connection project requirements as needed to ensure hydrologic health of the state park and the rare community assemblages found there. Project originally submitted for review on 10-15-2019.

- **Jake Wolf Memorial Fish Hatchery**

2003577—This project proposes to remove and replace site residence roofs at the hatchery. Project originally submitted for review on 10-15-2019.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

2002901—This project proposes to complete trail erosion repairs to Ravine Trail. Project originally submitted for review on 9-17-2019.

- **Rollo Prairie**

2003311—This project proposes to reshape the ponds and to plant native plugs all to create better habitat for the listed herpetofauna on site. Project originally submitted for review on 10-02-2019.
