## ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from December 16 to January 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Lincoln Log Cabin State Historic Site**

2102148—This project will replace or repair multiple roof assemblies contained within Lincoln Log Cabin State Historic Site. Project originally submitted for review on 08-07-2020.

- **Fort Massac**

2108602—This project will install a new fiber optic cable to the visitor center. Project originally submitted for review on 12-15-2020.

- **Jubilee College State Historic Site**

2107775—This project will remove hazardous dead or dying trees at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-30-2020.

- **Jim Edgar Panther Creek SFWA**

2108698—This project proposes to install a new water service line to the site residence. Project originally submitted for review on 12-17-2020.

- **Jim Edgar Panther Creek SFWA**

2108683—This project will install a new electric service line at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 12-17-2020.

- **Moraine View State Park**

2009765—This project proposes to seal the park road system, repair some failed culverts, and resurface various parking lots and sidewalks. Project originally submitted for review on 5-21-2020.

- **Vandalia Statehouse State Historic Site**

2103180—This project will replace two windowsills at the statehouse. Project originally submitted for review on 08-19-2020.

- **Starved Rock State Park**

2108434—This project will update the existing double doors on the north side of the Great Hall Lodge to ADA compliance. Project originally submitted for review on 12-11-2020.

- **Hennepin Canal**

2106573—This project will authorize clearing of debris and silt from five existing aqueducts. Project originally submitted for review on 10-16-2020.

- **Big River State Forest**

2101759—This project proposes to replace the roof of the large shelter building in the southern portion of the campground area. Project originally submitted for review on 7-31-2020.

- **Lake Le-Aqua-Na State Park**

2108451—This project authorizes offsite sediment placement from sediment removed from the former lake and other actions associated with the larger park renovations. Project originally submitted for review on 12-11-2020.

- **Kinkaid Lake State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2109260—This project allows the Kinkaid Reeds Creek Conservancy District egress across the site to make repairs to a gully on adjacent property. Project originally submitted for review on 1-11-2021.
