ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from November 16 to December 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

• **Union Co State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2206893—This project will install a security fence at the Belknap Headquarters at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-08-2021.

• **Castle Rock State Park**

2203369—This project will install fencing at the site residence. Project originally submitted for review on 8-25-2021.

• **Stephen A Forbes State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2206897—This project will repair and rehabilitate a wetland embankment at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-08-2021.

• **Wolf Creek State Park**

2201509—This project will replace shower buildings at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 7-30-2021.

• **Bishop Hill State Historic Site**

2107378—This project includes gate and fence repairs at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-16-2020.

• **Illinois Beach State Park (South Unit)**

1811512—This project will permit access to a new construction at Wadsworth and Sheridan. Project most recently submitted for review on 11-15-2021.

• **Chain O'Lakes State Park**

2206054—This project will permit planting of mitigation trees from the Fox Lake Interconnect Project. Project originally submitted for review on 10-06-2021.

• **Dana Thomas House**

2206813—This project will complete repairs to the Dana Thomas House foundation and masonry walls. Project originally submitted for review on 11-03-2021.

• **Hennepin Canal**

2200081—This project will repair and replace the roof at the Lock 33 Lock Tender's house. Project originally submitted for review on 7-02-2021.

• **Marseilles State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2206052—This project permits the Department of Military Affairs Illinois to renovate a pond located next to the Military Operations site at Marseilles SFWA. Project originally submitted for review on 10-06-2021.

• **Grant Home State Historic Site**

2205680—This project will complete wood repairs, cleaning, and repainting at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 9-28-2021.

• **Bishop Hill State Historic Site**

2107379—This project will restore the historic canons at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-16-2020.

• **Lincoln Trail Homestead**

2203364—This project permits site staff and volunteers to construct a primitive dirt trail at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 8-25-2021.

• **Moraine Hills State Park**

2206946—This project permits Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation Facility to install a 10" sanitary force main at Lily Lake and River roads. Project originally submitted for review on 11-10-2021.

- **Carl Sandburg State Historic Site**

2200006—This project will restore the exterior of the historic cottage at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 7-01-2021.

- **Fox Ridge State Park**

2109364—This project will remove the obsolete pumphouse at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 1-13-2021.

- **Starved Rock State Park**

2206359—This project will install a prefabricated playground equipment set at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 10-18-2021.

- **Starved Rock State Park**

2206017—This project will permit wood flooring repairs at the lodge great hall. Project originally submitted for review on 10-05-2021.

- **Woodford State Conservation Area**

2207280—This project permits dredging in the Illinois River to accommodate an IDOT project to replace EB US 150's arch truss bridge across the IL river. Project originally submitted for review on 11-25-2021.

- **Lake Le-Aqua-Na State Park**

2207660—This project permits ComEd to install a new service pedestal near an old one for electric service improvements. Project originally submitted for review on 12-08-2021.

- **Nauvoo State Park**

2206798—This project will complete the removal and re-installation of rain gutters at the Rheinberger House Museum at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-03-2021.
