ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from May 15 to June 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All of these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Nauvoo State Park**

1512679 - This project involves the rehabilitation to the Rheinberger House, including: remove fractured stone steps. Project was submitted for review on 5-19-15.

- **Lake Murphysboro State Park**

1512672 - This project involves stabilization of eroded stream banks immediately upstream of a low water crossing on the main park road. Project was submitted for review on 5-18-15.

- **World Shooting Recreation Complex**

1512649 - This project involves repairs to Cardinal Road. Project was submitted for review on 5-18-15.

- **Lowden State Park**

1509796 - This project involves the construction of a sidewalk in an existing day use area. Project was submitted for review on 2-27-15.

- **Horseshoe Lake State Park**

1512857 - This project involves repairs to the existing boat dock. Project was submitted for review on 5-26-15.

- **Horseshoe Lake State Park**

1512852 - This project involves removal of a dangerously deteriorated asphalt surfaced fishing pier. Project was submitted for review on 5-26-15.

- **Mississippi River State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1512320 - This project involves enhancements to an existing boat access point at Waverly Lake. Project was submitted for review on 5-11-15.

- **Hennepin Canal State Trail**

1512617 - This project involves temporary repairs to the existing levee to stabilize the damaged levee due to erosion from Bureau Creek. A permanent repair is in design. Project was submitted for review on 5-18-15.

- **Hennepin Canal Parkway**

1512859 - This project involves painting the Lock 33 lock tenders house in Rock Falls. Project was submitted for review on 5-26-15.

- **Horseshoe Lake State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1512700 - This project involves construction to improve the current waterfowl impoundments. Project was submitted for review on 5-19-15.

- **Mississippi River State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1506427 - This project involves improvements to the drainage of the Godar Refuge/Goadar Swamp area. Project was submitted for review on 10-16-14

- **Union County State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1513034 - This project involves repairing the levee to restore the wetland to its full capacity. Project was submitted for review on 6-1-15.
