## ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from May 16 to June 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Hennepin Canal**

2207662 & 2207663—This project proposes to repair and paint the bridge decks at Lock 26 and Bridge 15 on the canal. Project originally submitted for review on 12-08-2021.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

2212361—This project will clean an existing drainage ditch at the Carlyle Sailing Association at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-25-2022.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

2212704—This project will replace an existing electric service line using existing conduit, and replacing ten light fixtures at the Carlyle Sailing Association at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-04-2022.

- **Kinkaid Lake**

2212538—This project will make repairs to the existing boat access area at the Paul Ice Recreational Area at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 4-28-2022.

- **Dixon Springs State Park**

2211425—This project will construct a new section of retaining wall to stabilize a streambank adjacent to the swimming pool at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 3-30-2022.

- **Kinkaid Lake**

2213184—This project will permit KMI to inspect a location of their pipeline at Kinkaid Lake SFWA and

perform necessary maintenance. Project originally submitted for review on 5-17-2022.

- **Kaskaskia River State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2212703—This project proposes to construct a new Highwater Boat Ramp, driveway, boat dock, and walk at Evansville in Kaskaskia River SFWA. Project originally submitted for review on 5-04-2022.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

2212622—This project will replace the existing wood siding on the shower house at the Carlyle Sailing Association at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-02-2022.

- **Momence Wetlands State Natural Area**

2212577—This project will permit ComEd to remove dead ash trees along their service line. Project originally submitted for review on 4-29-2022.

- **Kankakee River State Park**

2212070—This project will permit Aqua Illinois to bore their waterline under the Davis Creek, associated with the W3100 N Rd. bridge replacement project that is forthcoming. Project originally submitted for review on 4-15-2022.

- **William W Powers State Recreation Area**

2212710—This project will complete the park signage project at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-04-2022.

- **Eagle Creek**

2213731—This project will rehabilitate the concrete boat ramp at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-31-2022.

- **Fox Creek State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2210394—This project will construct new hunter parking lots around the periphery of this new site. Project originally submitted for review on 3-08-2022.

- **Cache River State Natural Area**

2200373—This project will release target oaks and

cypress from crown competition to continue reforestation efforts. Project originally submitted for review on 7-09-2021.
