ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from April 16 to May 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Sangchris Lake State Park**

2112687—This emergency project installed a new water service line at the Hickory Point Campground. Project originally submitted for review on 4-15-2021.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

2111906—This project proposes to install an electric service line at the Sailing Association. Project originally submitted for review on 3-24-2021.

- **Washington County State Recreation Area**

2110839—This project will construct a new wastewater treatment plant and associated sewage infrastructure within WCSRA. Project originally submitted for review on 2-25-2021.

- **Ferne Clyffe State Park**

2111607—This project will allow access to Texas Eastern Transmission, LP to access its pipeline easement for maintenance, by a short section of the Buck Creek Horse Trail. Project originally submitted for review on 3-16-2021.

- **Washington County State Recreation Area**

2109255—This project will replace the roofs on several buildings at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 1-11-2021.

- **Lincoln Herndon Law Office State Historic Site**

1901661—This project will restore damaged wood door and wood storefront assemblies in attrition to repainting

various elements. Project most recently submitted for review on 4-22-2021.

- **Starved Rock State Park**

2112174—This project will install a new 200 amp electrical service to the Education building to accommodate new furnace and AC. Project originally submitted for review on 3-31-2021.

- **Starved Rock State Park**

2111448—This project will initiate restoration activities at a site known as Parkman's Plain, including invasive species removal and subsequent restoration plantings. Project originally submitted for review on 3-11-2021.

- **Jim Edgar Panther Creek**

2112923—This project will clean and shape the drainage of a ditch near parking lot C-13 that is backed up with silt. Project originally submitted for review on 4-21-2021.

- **Lincoln's New Salem State Historic Site**

2110162—This project proposes to replace 10 roof areas at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 2-05-2021.

- **Dana Thomas House State Historic Site**

2113341—This project will complete painting to the Dana Thomas House front door and masonry walls. Project originally submitted for review on 5-03-2021.

- **Hennepin Canal State Parkway**

2113359—This project involves contaminant sampling within Horseshoe Lake State Park and nearby Frank Holten State Recreation Area. Project originally submitted for review on 5-03-2021.

- **Fort Massac**

2113279—This project permits a broadband line to be strung across the canal from two existing poles. Project originally submitted for review on 4-06-2021.

- **Region 5 Headquarters**

2111661—This project will replace the reconstructed bridges at the fort. Project originally submitted for review

on 4-29-2021.

- **Wilmington District Office**

2113371—This project will pour a concrete slab in front of the CWD lab. Project originally submitted for review on 5-04-2021.

- **Goose Lake State Park**

2111748—This project will permit Kinder Morgan to investigate an anomaly within their pipeline easement via hydrovac on the shore. Project originally submitted for review on 3-19-2021.

- **Hennepin Canal**

2113421—This emergency project will repair a culvert at one of the canal's drainage adjacent ditch outfalls. Project originally submitted for review on 5-05-2021.

- **Jubilee College State Historic Site**

2107372—This project will replace the roof and perform other repairs at the Pump House at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 11-16-2021.

- **White Pines Forest State Park**

2113634—This project will remodel the bathrooms in the cabins at the site. Project originally submitted for review on 5-12-2021.

- **Fogelpole Cave Nature Preserve**

21113449—This project permits urgent inspection and repairs on a gas line with an easement that runs above the cave systems. Project originally submitted for review on 5-06-2021.
