ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from September 16 to October 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Sahara Woods State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2002975—This project was to review a slightly modified location of the OHV Campground Area. Project originally submitted for review on 9-19-2019.

- **Volo Bog State Natural Area**

2003578—This project proposes to repair the interpretive center silo cap. Project originally submitted for review on 10-15-2019.

- **Castle Rock State Park**

2003574—This project proposes to remove trees near the site residences that are impacting structures. Project originally submitted for review on 10-15-2019.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

2003419—This project proposes to complete repairs to various equestrian trail locations at the park. Project originally submitted for review on 10-07-2019.

- **Mazonia – Braidwood State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2003511—This project proposes to remove an inactive beaver dam to handle a flooding emergency. Project originally submitted for review on 10-10-2019.

- **Clinton Lake State Recreation Area**

2003405—This project proposes to install a long-term groundwater monitoring well at the Lane Day Use Area. Project originally submitted for review on 10-07-2019.

- **Rock Cut State Park**

2003332—This project proposes to allow ComEd to replace two electric pedestals and transformer equipment. Project originally submitted for review on 10-02-2019.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

2003289—This project will repair a waterline leak at the camp Piasa unit. Project originally submitted for review on 10-01-2019.

- **Clear Creek Wetland State Natural Area**

2003306—This project proposes to remove encroaching woody vegetation. Project originally submitted for review on 10-01-2019.

- **Sam Dale Lake Conservation Area**

2002763—This project proposes to raise parts of the horse trail where erosion problems persist. Project most recently submitted for review on 9-12-2019.

- **Saline County Fish and Wildlife Area**

2002746—This project will replace a concrete ford crossing on an intermittent stream. Project originally submitted for review on 9-12-2019.

- **Cache River State Natural Area**

2002727—This project is to construct an access road to one of the proposed sediment containment basins required for the greater Cache River dredging project. Project originally submitted for review on 9-11-2019.

- **Chain O' Lakes State Park**

2002568—This project proposes to manipulate hardwood canopy to stimulate oak regeneration. Project originally submitted for review on 9-09-2019.

- **Union County State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2003081—This project plans to repair a failed levee. Project originally submitted for review on 9-24-2019.

- **Horseshoe Lake State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2002985—This project proposes to allow Ameren to install a new overhead electric line adjoining Cypress Drive. Project originally submitted for review on 9-19-2019.

- **Frank Holten State Park**

2002738—This project proposes to construct a new engineered pole building at Frank Holten State Park. Project originally submitted for review on 9-11-2019.

- **Banner Marsh State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2002785—This project proposes to aerially spray *Phragmites* clones. Project originally submitted for review on 9-12-2019.

- **Double T State Fish and Wildlife Area**

2002786—This project proposes to aerially spray *Phragmites* clones. Project originally submitted for review on 9-12-2019.

- **Kidd Lake Marsh State Natural Area**

2002887—This project proposes to replace a culvert and water control structure. Project originally submitted for review on 9-17-2019.

- **I & M Canal**

2002538—This project is for geotechnical soil borings and construction to replace the Nettle Creek Aqueduct. Project originally submitted for review on 9-11-2019.
