PUBLIC NOTICE

PIER SYSTEM RECONFIGURATION ON FOX LAKE IN LAKE VILLA BY ELECTRIC HARBOR MARINA

Electric Harbor Marina, 38470 N. Columbia Bay Road, Lake Villa, Illinois 60046 has applied for a permit from the IDNR, Office of Water Resources for a pier system reconfiguration at the marina. The site is located on the east side of Columbia Bay, within Fox Lake. This public notice is being issued pursuant to State rules for the regulation of public waters.

The pier system consists of 4 main piers, and all the piers will be shifted to the north. There are three piers south of the boat ramp which all extend 250 feet into the Bay. The southern-most two are transient, and 50 feet apart. The third pier extends out into the water at an angle with a 223.5 ft pier that extends to the north. This section has 34 spaces for boat parking. The pier that is north of the boat ramp also extends to an angle to the north, and this pier has 3 spaces for boat parking. The pier system will be 27 feet away from the pier to the south and will be 76 feet away from the pier to the north. The piers will serve the marina.

The project site is located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 36, Township 46 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Lake County. A pier plan is on the back of this public notice.

No work is to start on this project unless and until the permit is issued.

Plans for the proposed work may be seen by appointment at the Northeastern Illinois Regulatory Programs Section office, 2050 West Stearns Road, Bartlett, Illinois 60103. Review of this project will be limited to the following issues: 1) Any obstruction to, or interference with the navigability of Fox Lake; 2) Any encroachment on Fox Lake; and 3) Any impairment of the rights, interests or uses of the public on Fox Lake or in the natural resources thereof.

You are invited to send written comments regarding the proposed work to the Bartlett Office by November 13, 2020.
