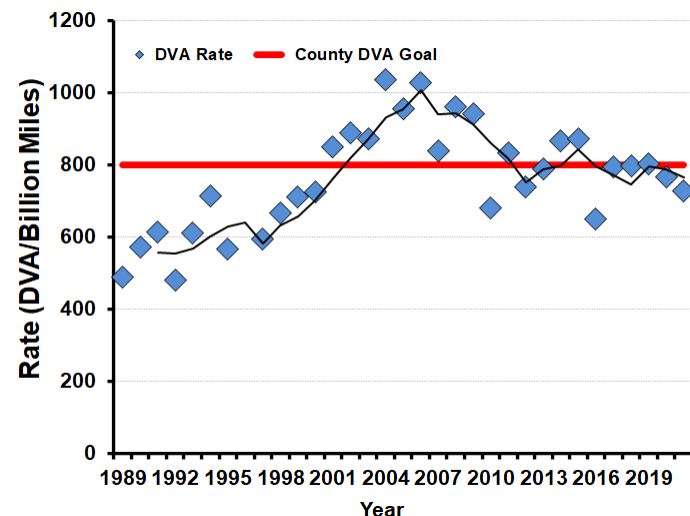

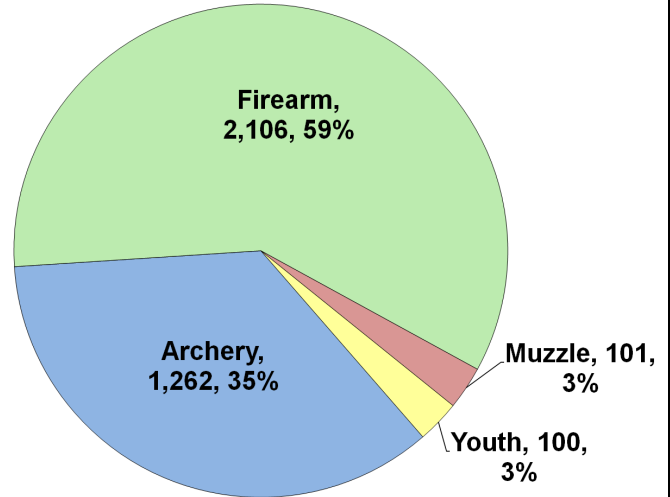
Late Winter/CWD Season in 2022-2023: No.

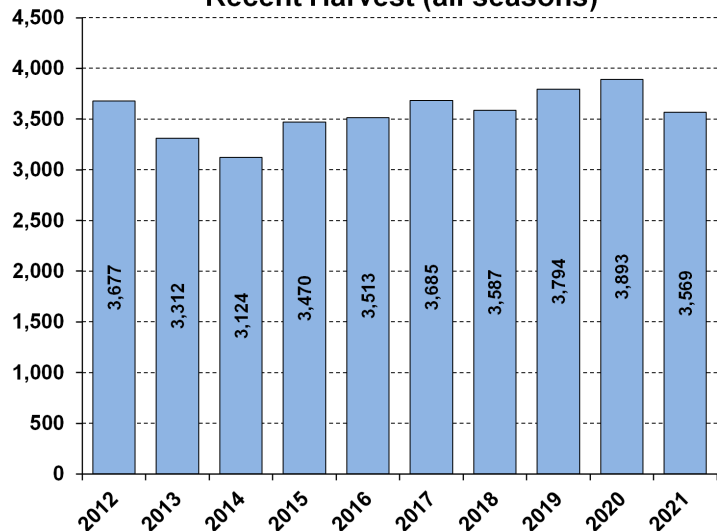
Last year in Late Winter/CWD: Starting 2022
