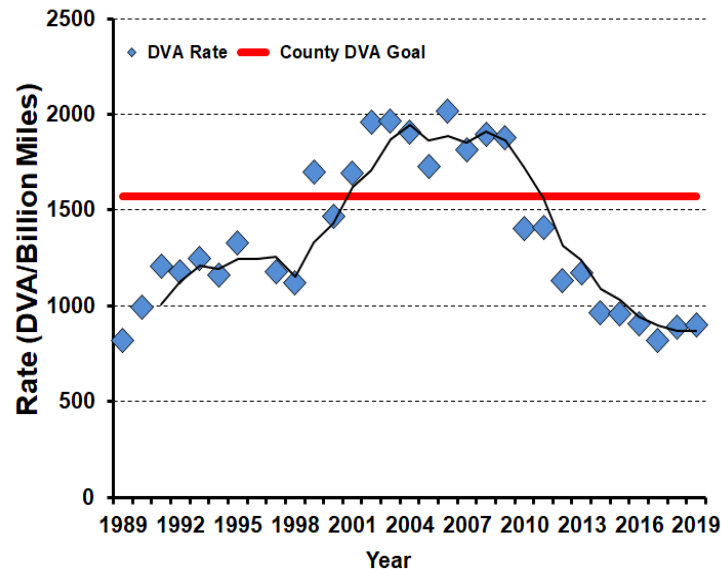

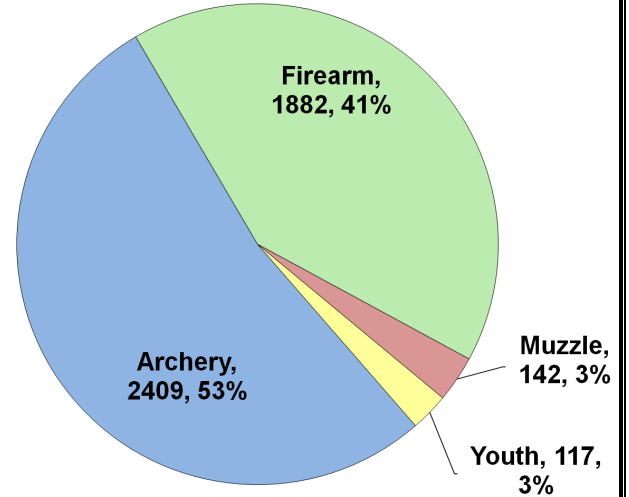
**Late Winter/CWD Season in 2021-2022:** No.
