



HUNTERS: If selected, you will be able to bring up to three guests to assist you. The guests may also hunt and do not have to be disabled. The permit holder must be present at all times.

Any hunter confined to a wheelchair, or unable to retrieve his/her own downed birds MUST bring at least one guest to assist them. Clinton Lake State Recreation Area site personnel are not able to provide assistance.

Hunt dates will be divided equally between all disabled applicants. A lottery will be conducted for remaining dates so there is a chance for hunters to draw for more than one hunt date. Applicants will be sent a map, fact sheet and instructions on how to obtain the Site/Lottery-Drawn Windshield Card.
