Disabled Archery Hunt Application Information

- The designated hunting area has one hard plastic, handicapped-accessible hunting blind. The blind will accommodate up to two people, one licensed hunter and an optional assistant.
- Applications may be completed on site, emailed to bryan.eubanks@illinois.gov, or mailed to: Walnut Point State Park, 2331 East County Rd 370 N, Oakland, IL 61943.
- The open application period will be annually from August 1st until September 15th.
- Hunters may select up to 3 weekly hunting periods on their application, if awarded each applicant will be given one week to hunt.
- Weekly hunting periods will start on Monday and go through the following Sunday.
- There will be no standby option.
- Successful applicants will be required to show proof of Class P2A or higher disability, purchase statewide archery deer permits and meet all license requirements prior to hunting.
