Presentation on Nettle Creek Aqueduct Project Set for Nov. 19

MORRIS, Ill. – The public is invited to register for an online presentation Nov. 19 on plans to repair the historic Nettle Creek Aqueduct on the Illinois and Michigan Canal in Morris.

The online presentation will be via Webex and members of the public who wish to view the presentation and ask questions regarding the project can register via the link below.

Details on the Nettle Creek Aqueduct project will be presented by representatives of the Illinois Capital Development Board (CDB), the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR), along with the architectural/engineering firm EXP U.S. Services, Inc. and historic structure consultants Johnson Lasky Kindelin Architects (JLK).

The Nettle Creek Aqueduct, first constructed between 1844 and 1847 as part of the I&M Canal, experienced an unexpected failure during severe flooding in 2013.

The presentation on the project is scheduled to be conducted on Thursday, Nov. 19 from 6:00-7:30 p.m.
