WILDLAND FIREFIGHTER TRAINING

The below classes are required training for IDNR employees that work on prescribed fires, suppression fires, incident qualification cards (red cards) and the "Illinois Certified Prescribed Burn Manager" program. The below classes are also required for non-IDNR persons interested in a red card and/or the Certified Prescribed Burn Manager program.

Eighty percent of the training can be completed online. In addition to the online training a one-day field day is also required. The online classes are required to be completed prior to attending a field day.

The online training certificates are to be printed and copies submitted with your application to attend a field day training.
