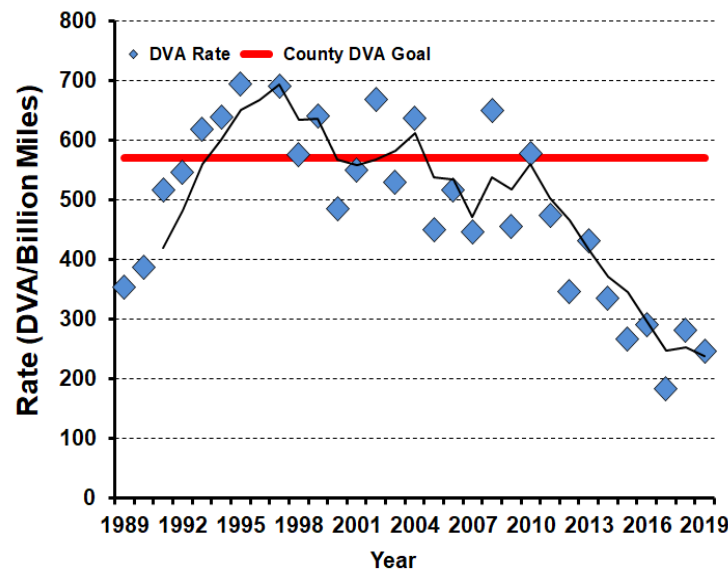

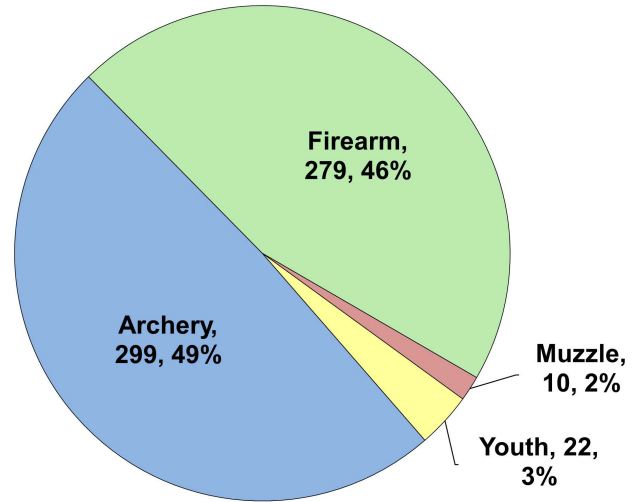
Late Winter/CWD Season in 2020-2021: No.

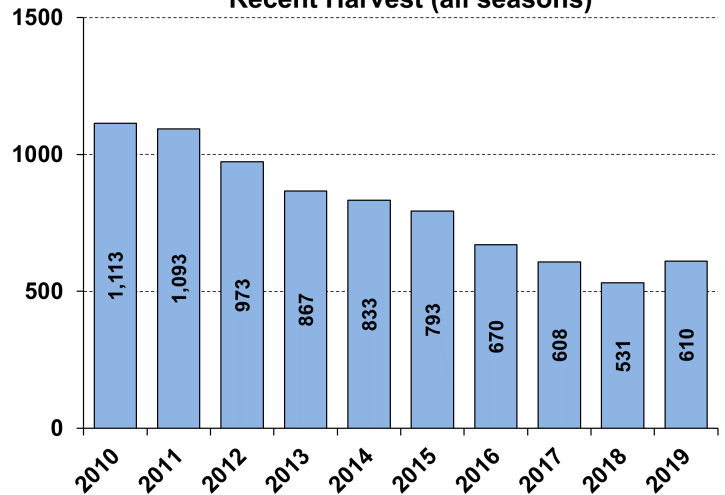
