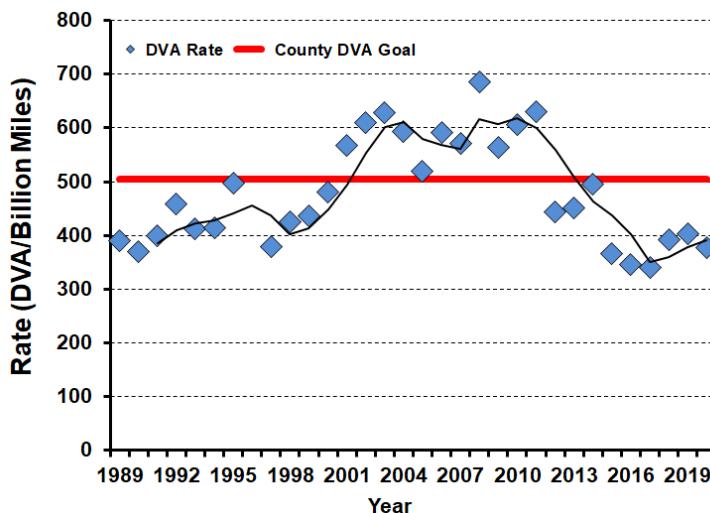

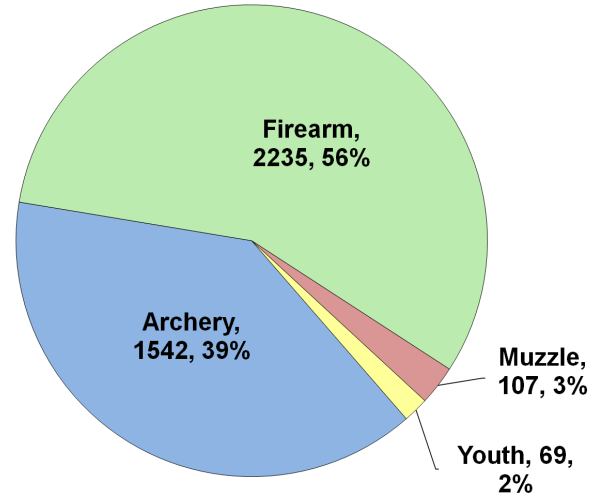
Late Winter/CWD Season in 2021-2022: No.

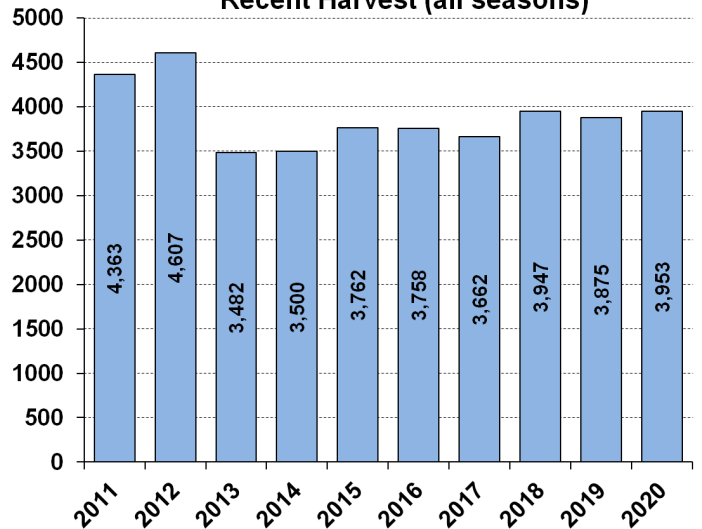
Last year in Late Winter/CWD: 2014
