

reduce deer density and disease transmission.




**CWD** positive deer 2021-2022: 28

IDNR sharpshooting: 126 deer were removed via sharpshooting which is used to supplement hunter harvest, allows localized deer reductions in known CWD positive areas to reduce transmission rates and environmental contamination. Through these efforts CWD prevalence has remained low (see below).
