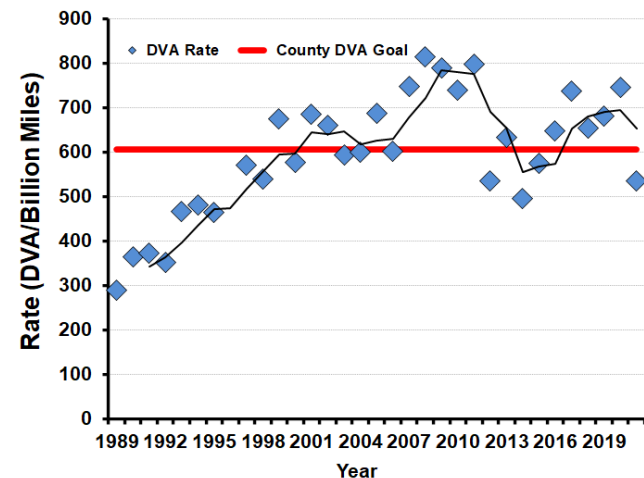

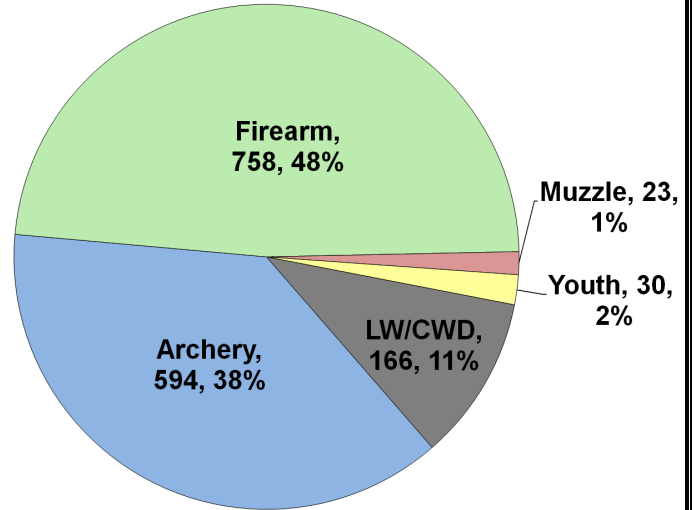

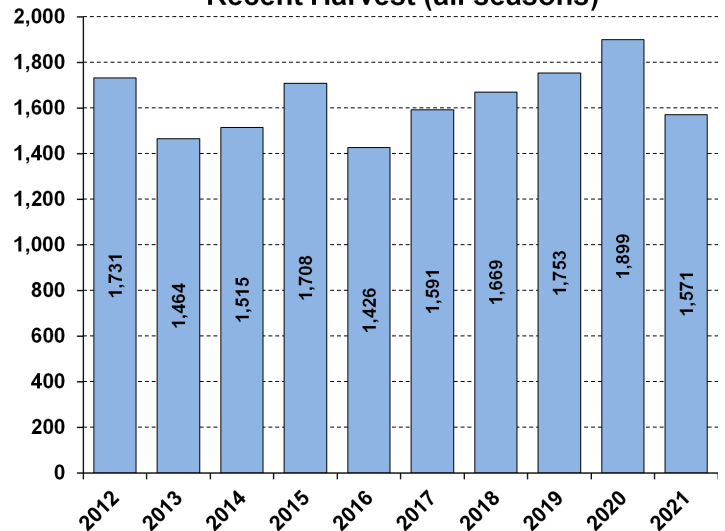
Time in Late Winter: 2019 - Present
