

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN UNITED STATES ARMY GARRISON-ROCK ISLAND ARSENAL
AND THE
ILLINOIS STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
REGARDING WINDOW REPLACEMENT FOR BUILDINGS 60, 62 AND 68 AT THE
ROCK ISLAND ARSENAL IN ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS the United States Army Garrison-Rock Island Arsenal (RIA) plans to replace windows at Buildings 60, 62 and 68, Rock Island Arsenal, contributing structures to the Rock Island Arsenal Historic District National Historic Landmark, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS RIA has determined that this undertaking will have an adverse effect on Buildings 60, 62 and 68 and has consulted with the Illinois State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 C.F.R. part 800, of the regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. § 470f); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 36 C.F.R. § 800.6(a)(1), RIA has notified the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) of its adverse effect determination with specified documentation and the ACHP has chosen not to participate in the consultation pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.6(a)(1)(iii); and

NOW, THEREFORE, RIA and the SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

STIPULATIONS


Rock Island Arsenal shall ensure that the following measures are carried out:

1. Prior to the initiation of construction activities, the RIA shall ensure that the all window style configurations within the buildings are photographed and architectural drawings are done in accordance with the Standards and Guidelines of the Illinois Historic American Building Survey. One copy shall be provided to the SHPO for future reference and one copy shall be kept at the Directorate of Public Works for future reference. Twelve windows from each of the three buildings shall be saved on premises for future use and/or reference.
2. The replacement windows shall be aluminum to match the existing as closely as possible in color and configuration. Shop drawings of the replacement windows shall be submitted to the SHPO for review and approval in writing prior to initiation of project.


