On June 27, 2019, the Illinois EPA received a letter on behalf of Dynergy Midwest Generation, LLC ("Applicant") withdrawing the pending application for a water quality certification under Section 401 of the federal Clean Water Act. The Applicant's water quality certification application was received by the Illinois EPA on July 3, 2018, for a bank stabilization project on the Middle Fork Vermilion River. On March 26, 2019, and due to significant public interest, a public hearing was held at the Mary Miller Gymnasium at Danville Area Community College. Since the application has been withdrawn, no further action will occur on the application and a responsiveness summary will not be distributed for this proceeding.
