I agree to notify the Illinois EPA within 60 days of failing to satisfy any of these eligibility criteria and will be required to reimburse the Illinois EPA the amount of the rebate.

# ILLINOIS ELECTRIC VEHICLE REBATE PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Vehicles must be purchased on or after July 1, 2022

## MAILING ADDRESS

The rebate application with required information and documentation must be printed and mailed to the Illinois EPA. Applications **will not** be accepted by fax, email or hand delivery. Applications must be mailed to the address below and contain a postmark.

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

The rebate application must be postmarked within 90 days of the vehicle purchase date.

**and**

The rebate application must be postmarked on or before the end of the rebate cycle, September 30, 2022.

## COMPLETENESS REQUIREMENT

All information requested in the application must be provided in legible fashion. Illegible, Incomplete or late applications will be denied.

## FUND AVAILABILITY

All applications for rebate are subject to fund availability.

## APPLICATION

### Section 1: Applicant Information

- Provide your name, physical street address (**no** P.O. Box), email address (if available), and your daytime or cell phone number. Provide your mailing address if different from the physical address. This physical address will be used to confirm the Illinois residency requirement. It is also where the comptroller will mail any rebate check unless you provide a different mailing address in which case that will be the location to which any rebate check is mailed. The cell phone number is for contact purposes should that become necessary.
- Check each of the statements acknowledging that you understand and meet the program eligibility criteria to receive a rebate.

### Section 2: Vehicle Information

- Check whether this application is for an electric vehicle or an electric motorcycle
- Check whether you purchased a NEW or USED/PRE-OWNED electric vehicle or electric motorcycle from an Illinois dealer

- Insert the purchase date of the vehicle
- Insert the Make (manufacturer), Model, and Model Year of the vehicle or motorcycle
- Insert the entire Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)

### **Section 3: Dealership Information**

This Section should be completed by the selling Illinois dealership. Enter the name of the dealership, the dealership's license number issued by the Illinois Secretary of State, and the dealership's address and phone number. A representative of the dealership is to certify that the information in Sections 2 and 3 of the application are true and accurate with signature and printed name.

### **Section 4: Documentation**

Check each of the statements to ensure that the required documents and forms are included with the application. Legible copies of the documents are acceptable.

The links to the required IRS W-9 Form (if you have a social security number) and IRS W-8 Form (if you have a taxpayer identification number) are provided on the website. The Office of the Illinois Comptroller requires an individual's social security number or a taxpayer identification number to process payment and issue a state check. The application cannot be processed without a completed W-9 or W-8, and as such would be deemed incomplete and denied.

Note: The IRS W-9 or IRS W-8 information must match the information on file with the IRS. Rebate checks issued by the Comptroller will be mailed to that address, which must be the physical or mailing address provided in Section 1 of the application.

### **Section 5: Low-Income Certification**

The Electric Vehicle Rebate regulations define "low income" as persons and families whose income does not exceed 80% of the State median income for the State fiscal year (July 1, 2021 - June 30, 2022), as established by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The regulations further provide that to qualify as "low income," the total combined gross income of the applicant and all persons over the age of 18 living at applicant's residence and related to applicant by blood, marriage, or adoption cannot exceed 80% of the State median income.

The applicant's household count is to be determined by totaling the applicant and any individual or group of individuals living with the applicant as one economic unit, which may include persons under the age of 18 and persons unrelated to applicant by blood, marriage, or adoption.

The applicant's income level is to be determined by totaling the combined gross income of the applicant and all persons over the age of 18 living at applicant's residence and related to applicant by blood, marriage, or adoption.

After determining the applicant's household count and income level as previously noted, find the appropriate calculated household count in the table below. If the applicant's calculated gross income level is at or below the corresponding income level threshold, the applicant is considered low income. For example, an applicant whose household count is 3 must have an income level at or below the income level threshold of \$68,656 to be considered low income.
