

Hardship Waiver Statistics

It is the intent of the Illinois General Assembly to ease the burden of estate recovery for correctly paid benefits to participants, applicants, and their families and heirs, and to make information about waivers more widely available. The Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) will waive estate recovery where recovery would work an undue hardship. Information and instructions for completing a request for a hardship waiver is available in six languages (English, Spanish, Polish, Chinese, Tagalog and Arabic) on this website. In determining the value of an estate, HFS will consider the gross assets in the estate, including, but not limited to, the net value of real estate less mortgages or liens with priority over HFS' claims. Information regarding the number of estate recovery cases that were pursued in the previous two fiscal years and the number and demographics of hardship waivers that were granted are presented below.
