

Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice – Covid-19 Screening Documentation (effective 3/17/20) Date: \_\_\_\_\_ Shift: \_\_\_\_\_

The screener shall ask everyone entering the facility the screening questions and document each person’s name, responses, and temperature taken by infrared thermometer (if available). If any one responds “yes” to any question or has a temperature of 100.5 degrees or greater, contact the DAO (or Shift Supervisor).

Impacted countries are: China, Iran, Italy, Japan, South Korea, and EU including UK & Ireland (This list may be expanded over time)

“Close Contact” means, for example, being in the same household, being within 6 feet for more than 10 consecutive minutes or having physical contact.
