10:00 – 1:00 The training will provide a comprehensive overview of the changes to the standards for treatment and evaluation of sex offenders in Illinois. Each of the speakers will present on how the SOMB standards guide their work.

Jake Harlow will address the early phases of the spectrum to include probation, pre-trial issues, use of assessments and presentence investigations, treatment review and compliance.

Michael Kleppin will discuss the impact that the changes to the standards and guidelines have had on community based treatment and evaluation.

Margaret Menzenberger will present an overall view of SVP cases, how evaluations are utilized, what needs to be included in evaluations, and issues that may occur in relation to the standards.

Dr. Shan Jumper will address treatment and evaluation with the individuals committed as Sexually Violent Persons and for those being considered for conditional release.

Following the individual presentations, there will be a moderated panel discussion and Q & A with the four presenters participating.
