## **Executive Summary**

This report is compiled to satisfy the requirements of Chapter 730 ILCS 5/5-8-1.1. The current Impact Incarceration Programs (IIP) facilities are located at Dixon Springs in the Shawnee National Forest in southeastern Illinois and at the DuQuoin State Fairgrounds in southern Illinois.

In FY2010, judges from 82 counties referred 1,206 inmates to participate in IIP. Of those admitted into IIP, 84% (1,011) successfully completed the program and were released to Mandatory Supervised Release (MSR) in the community. The 3-Year recidivism rate for FY2007 IIP releases was 40.6% compared with the overall departmental recidivism rate of 47.8% for the same year.

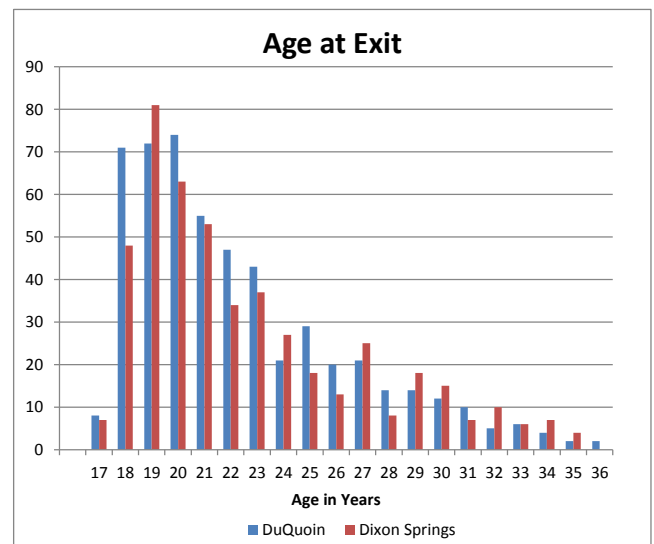
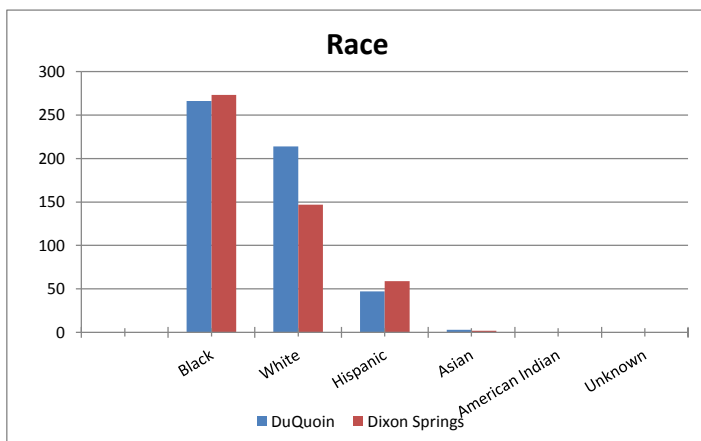
