The hearing involves the written objections and hearing request filed by Petitioner(s), attached hereto and made a part hereof (Exhibit A).



The proceedings are subject to judicial review in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101 et seq. The Director of Labor's determination on the objections is final and binding unless a party to this proceeding applies for and obtains judicial review of the final administrative decision in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law.

Dear Mr. Beyer:

This Firm represents the Associated General Contractors of Illinois ("AGCI"), the Southern Illinois Builders Association ("SIBA"), ET Simonds Co. ("ET Simonds"), and United Contractors Midwest ("UCM"), collectively "Petitioners." I am writing on Petitioners' behalf to provide written notice objecting to the Illinois Department of Labor's Prevailing Wage Rates Effective July 10, 2017. Notice is provided pursuant to 820 ILCS §§ 130/4 and 130/9.

AGCI and SIBA represent numerous construction industry employers in Illinois that pay prevailing wage rates on public projects and who are financially affected by those rates. ET Simonds and UCM are construction industry employers in Illinois and pay prevailing wage rates on public projects and are financially affected by those rates.

Petitioners have assembled a table of the errors and omissions in the prevailing wage rates published by the Department effective July 10, 2017. I have attached the table as Exhibit A.

Petitioners request an investigatory hearing to establish the proper prevailing wage rates for the counties, regions, and types of work identified in Exhibit A.

So we may prepare for the hearing, please forward to me the information the Department of Labor relied upon in making the wage rate determinations.


