ORDER

IDOL File No.: 2021-H-RP08-2330 coming on to be heard under the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 – 12 (“the Act” or “PWA”), and in accordance with Article 10 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, 5 ILCS 100/10-5 – 10-70 and the procedures stated in the Department of Labor’s Rules at 56 Ill Admin Code 120.100, *et seq.*, the Notice of Hearing issued thereunder, all parties being on notice, on my own motion I, issue this Order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Hearing in IDOL File No.: 2021-H-RP08-2330, remains set for **SEPTEMBER 10, 2020 at 4:00 P.M.**, by telephone.

2. The parties and their respective representatives must be prepared to proceed at the hearing. The parties must present all information, documents, records or witnesses necessary to substantiate each party’s position at the Hearing.
3. On **AUGUST 26, 2020 at 3:00 p.m.**, I will convene a prehearing conference. I, or a State Conference Operator, will telephone:

4. The prehearing conference is for the purposes set forth in 56 Ill Admin Code 120.320 and 56 Ill Admin Code 120.400, including, simplification of the issues, stipulations, intervention, limitation of the number of witnesses, and any other appropriate matters.
5. Petitions to Intervene must comply with 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320. Failure to file the Petition to Intervene in accordance with 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320 will result in the Petition not being in compliance with this order and subsequent denial. Any Petition to Intervene filed after AUGUST 31, 2020 will be deemed untimely and will unduly delay or prejudice the adjudication of rights of the original parties.
6. Pursuant to 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.640, the administrative law judge will issue a Decision and Order. In the event no timely or proper exceptions are filed, the findings, conclusions, recommendations and order of the administrative law judge will automatically become the decision and order of the Director of Labor.
7. The proceedings are subject to judicial review in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101 *et seq.* The Director of Labor's determination on the objections is final and binding unless a party to this proceeding applies for and obtains judicial review of the final administrative decision in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law.
