LaSalle St., Ste. C-1300, Chicago, IL 60601 or to DOL.hearings@illinois.gov WITHIN 15 CALENDAR DAYS OF THE ORDER. A written decision on all motions shall be issued with notice to all parties. 56 Ill Admin Code 300.1160.
