Call to Order

Chairman Mike Chamness called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone attending via the Webex meeting. A roll call was taken, and quorum was established.

Update on Safe2Help Illinois Project

Chairman Chamness reported that the Safe2Help website is anticipated to go live on August 1. Illinois State Police Statewide Terrorism and Intelligence Center (STIC) has hired five of the six tip line analysts. Four of the five analysts have completed the training needed to support the Safe2Help tip line, and the fifth analyst is in the initial phase of training. The tip line and texting software has been procured. The five-digit texting code (SAFE2) is anticipated to be finalized/approved with communications carriers by the end of the month. STIC is resuming procurement and implementation of additional youth mental health training (now being offered virtually due to COVID-19). Director Tate-Nadeau, Homeland Security Advisor, approved a pilot launch of the program with one school district (most likely in Sangamon County) when school starts. The next phase would expand the program to a school district in each of the eight IEMA regions.

Cyber Security Briefing

Adam Ford, Chief Information Security Officer, Illinois Department of Innovation and Technology, provided a briefing on cybersecurity issues. Discussion followed.

Old Business

Status update on projects using SFY 20 Preparedness and Response (PAR) Grant Funds

Bob Evans, IEMA Preparedness Grants Section Manager, provided a status update on the SFY 20 PAR funds that expired on June 30, 2020. He displayed a spreadsheet summation of the various SFY 20 PAR projects (attached).

SFY 21 Preparedness and Response Grant (PAR) Project Requests

Bob Evans displayed a spreadsheet of the approved SFY 21 tiered projects and the grant award amounts (attached). Chairman Chamness explained that if the project funds are not all expended, they will return to IEMA, and the Chairs will discuss and review the projects for the funds to be reallocated. These funds expire on June 30, 2021.

Status update on projects using FFY 17 SHSP funds

Bob Evans provided a status update on unallocated FFY 17 SHSP funds. These funds will expire August 31, 2021. One of the approved projects discussed using the unallocated FFY 17 SHSP (local) funds and unallocated state-retained UASI funds was for an upgrade of the Illinois State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC). The first part of the upgrade involves purchasing web software upgrades in the amount of \$140,000. A Request for Information (RFI) has been submitted.
