

Caught Drinking Underage
Lose your driving privileges for a minimum of 3 months, regardless of whether you are driving at the time.

Presenting False Identification
Lose your driving privileges for a year and, if convicted, pay up to a \$2,500 fine and face up to a year in jail. Class 4 felony charges may also apply (up to 3 years imprisonment and fines up to \$25,000).

Drinking Under 21 or Assisting Underage Drinking is a Crime

it's a 2-way street...

Knowingly Allow Underage Drinking in Your Home
Subject to a felony. Spend up to 3 years in jail and pay a \$25,000.00 max fine if serious injury or death occurs.

Assisting Underage Drinking
Spend up to a year in jail and pay a \$2,500.00 max fine.

it's a 2-way street...

Don't Start the Trail That Ends in Jail*

Selling Alcohol to Someone Under 21

Spend up to a year in jail, pay a \$2500.00 max fine, liquor license fined/suspended/revoked

red bar = under 21



*Selling to a minor is a criminal offense, and will result in the seller's arrest if the sale occurs during a police underage compliance check operation.
