### **Liquor Control Commission November Underage Compliance Report**

SPRINGFIELD – In November 2019, the Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) conducted compliance checks around the state and visited 89 businesses licensed to sell liquor. They cited 10 for violations of liquor control laws.

This is a monthly aggregated report of all the underage compliance investigations conducted in the month of November. The ILCC may release results on individual investigations through shorter press releases throughout the month.

The monthly aggregated report lists all the results of ongoing undercover and cooperative law enforcement operations conducted by Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) agents, local law enforcement officials and volunteers from high schools and colleges. The teams randomly visit liquor stores, restaurants and bars in communities around the state to check for ongoing compliance with state laws mandating that no liquor is sold to minors under the age of 21. ILCC agents also work with local and state law enforcement agents to focus on communities with a high incidence of underage liquor sales.

**Below is the bulleted list by location of which establishments violated the law by selling alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Because the visits are random in nature, certain areas of the State are visited at certain times of the year.**

**Waterloo** – November 6<sup>th</sup>, the ILCC and the Waterloo Police Department conducted underage alcohol checks. Of the 32 licensees checked, three sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Those licensees were:

- SCHNUCKS, 150 WATERLOO COMMONS DR, WATERLOO, IL 62298-1081
- APPLEBEE'S, 923 N ILLINOIS RT 3, WATERLOO, IL 62296
- IMO'S PIZZA, 654 N MARKET ST, WATERLOO, IL 62298-1012

**Peoria** – November 12<sup>th</sup>, the ILCC and the Peoria Police Department conducted underage alcohol checks. Of the 19 licensees checked, three sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Those licensees were:

- OLD CHICAGO RESTAURANT, 7610 N GRAND PRAIRIE DRIVE, PEORIA, IL 61615-0000
- HOLIDAY INN & SUITES, 7601 N ORANGE PRAIRIE RD, PEORIA, IL 61615-9325
- CHILI'S GRILL & BAR, 4825 N UNIVERSITY ST, PEORIA, IL 61614-5832

**Macon County** – November 19<sup>th</sup>, the ILCC and the Macon County Sherriff’s Office conducted underage alcohol checks. Of the 20 licensees checked, three sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Those licensees were:

- CIRCLE K #470116, 3002 N WATER ST, DECATUR, IL 62526-2465
- LOVE'S TRAVEL STOP #746, 3925 COUNTY FAIR DR, DECATUR, IL 62526-2157

**Kankakee** – November 26<sup>th</sup>, the ILCC and the Kankakee Police Department conducted underage alcohol checks. Of the 18 licensees checked, one sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Those licensees were:

- CASEY'S GENERAL STORE #2368, 1075 W JEFFERY ST, KANKAKEE, IL 60901 (1 prior violation)
