Gov. Pritzker Names Lisa McLeod Executive Director of the Illinois Liquor Control Commission

CHICAGO— Lisa McLeod was named the new Executive Director of the Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC). McLeod joins the ILCC following an over 10-year career as a legal professional.
