Cancellation Fee: One full per-diem fee for cancellations of less than thirty days' notice.
Travel Expenses: When applicable
Training/Facilitated Bargaining: \$2000 per diem fee

NOTE: If, at the request of the parties, any case originally set for arbitration is instead mediated, the mediation rates shall apply.
