**Minutes of the Local Panel Meeting**  
**Held on May 12, 2011**

**I. OPENING OF MEETING 10:00 A.M.—160 North LaSalle Street, Suite S-400, Chicago, IL**

**II. PRESENT**

Jacalyn J. Zimmerman, Chairman; Charles E. Anderson, Member of the Board; Edward E. Sadlowski, Member of the Board; John F. Brosnan, Executive Director; Jerald S. Post, General Counsel; and staff members. Sharon B. Wells also acted as counsel to the Board at this meeting.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD APRIL 12, 2011**

Chairman Zimmerman requested minor modifications of the draft minutes of the April 12, 2011 meeting. After the Board discussed the proposal, Member Anderson moved to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2011 meeting, with the requested modifications thereto. Member Sadlowski seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

**IV. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

Chairman Zimmerman asked Executive Director Brosnan to present the Local Panel administrative actions report for the period of time from April 1 to April 30, 2011. He presented the report and summarized its highlights. The Board examined the report and discussed it.

**V. BOARD ACTIONS**

**1. Case No. L-CA-10-026**

**International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 21/City of Chicago/  
Service Employees International Union, Local 73**

Chairman Zimmerman called the case. General Counsel Post reviewed the issues presented by the exceptions to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Harvey's Recommended Decision and Order, and recommended that the Board reject the ALJ's recommendation. After discussion, Member Anderson moved to reject the ALJ's recommendation. Chairman Zimmerman seconded the motion. Chairman Zimmerman and Member Anderson passed the motion by a voice vote. Member Sadlowski opposed, contending that the ALJ's recommendation should be accepted. Member Anderson withdrew his motion, and Chairman Zimmerman withdrew her second. After further discussion, Member Anderson moved to specifically reject the ALJ's determination that the City of Chicago repudiated the collective bargaining agreement with International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 21, and Service Employees International Union, Local 73. Member Sadlowski seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote. Member Anderson moved to reject the balance of the ALJ's decision and to dismiss the underlying complaint. Chairman Zimmerman seconded the motion. Chairman Zimmerman and Member Anderson passed the motion by a voice vote. Member Sadlowski opposed, contending that apart from the finding on repudiation, the remainder of the ALJ's recommendation should be accepted.

**2. Case No. L-CB-11-001**

**Jeanette Mallette/American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31**

Chairman Zimmerman called the case, noting that Executive Director Brosnan issued a dismissal on September 9, 2010, with an appeal filed. Counsel Wells reviewed the issues presented by the appeal, and recommended that the Board uphold the Executive Director's order. After discussion, Member Sadlowski

moved to accept the Executive Director's order. Member Anderson seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**VI. OTHER BOARD MATTERS**

Executive Director Brosnan presented the fiscal report, reviewing in detail the general ledger sheet and the disbursement record. Thereafter, he updated the Board as to the status of legislation that could affect the agency. After a short discussion regarding whether there was a need for executive session, the Board concluded that it was unnecessary at this time.

**VII. ADJOURNMENT**

Chairman Zimmerman called for a motion to adjourn. Member Sadlowski made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.
