Minutes of the State Panel Meeting
Held on April 13, 2010

I. OPENING OF MEETING 11:00 A.M.—160 North LaSalle Street, Suite S-400, Chicago, IL

II. PRESENT

Jacalyn J. Zimmerman, Chairman; Michael Coli, Member of the Board; Michael Hade, Member of the Board; Albert Washington, Member of the Board; John F. Brosnan, Executive Director; Jerald S. Post, General Counsel; and staff members.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 23, 2010

Chairman Zimmerman called for approval of the minutes of the February 23, 2010 meeting. Member Washington moved to approve the minutes. Member Hade seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

IV. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Chairman Zimmerman asked Executive Director Brosnan to distribute the State Panel administrative actions report for the period of time from February 1 through March 31, 2010. He distributed the report to the Board and summarized its highlights. The Board examined the report and discussed it.

V. BOARD ACTIONS

1. Case No. S-RC-10-046

American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31/State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services

Chairman Zimmerman called the case. General Counsel Post reviewed the issues presented by the exceptions to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Strizak's Recommended Decision and Order (RDO), and recommended that the Board accept the result determined by the ALJ. After discussion, Member Hade moved to accept General Counsel Post's recommendation. Member Washington seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

2. Case No. S-RC-10-027

Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council/Village of Willowbrook

Chairman Zimmerman called the case. General Counsel Post reviewed the issues presented by the exceptions to ALJ Strizak's RDO, and recommended that the Board remand the case for hearing on certain issues. After the Board discussed the matter, Member Coli moved to accept General Counsel Post's recommendation. Member Washington seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

3. Case No. S-RC-08-048

American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31/State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services

Chairman Zimmerman called the case. General Counsel Post reviewed the issues presented by the exceptions to ALJ Harvey's RDO, and recommended that the Board accept the result determined by the

ALJ. Chairman Zimmerman, while generally agreeing with General Counsel Post's recommendation, urged the inclusion of a footnote in the written decision regarding the petitioned-for employees' authority to issue written reprimands. After the Board discussed the issues and considered Chairman Zimmerman's proposal, Member Hade moved to accept General Counsel Post's recommendation with Chairman Zimmerman's qualification. Member Washington seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**4. Case No. S-CA-08-109
International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 325/Village of Roscoe**

Chairman Zimmerman called the case, noting that no party filed exceptions to ALJ Wells' RDO, and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

**5. Case No. S-CA-07-095
Metropolitan Alliance of Police/Village of Romeoville**

Chairman Zimmerman called the case, noting that no party filed exceptions to ALJ Strizak's RDO, and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

**6. Case No. S-UC-06-090
American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31/State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services**

Chairman Zimmerman called the case, noting that no party filed exceptions to ALJ Harvey's RDO, and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

**7. Case No. S-CA-07-035
Association of Professional Police Officers/City of Aurora**

Chairman Zimmerman called the case, noting that no party filed exceptions to ALJ Wells' RDO, and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

VI. OTHER BOARD MATTERS

The Board heard and considered the fiscal and legislative reports in a joint panel meeting earlier on this date. After a short discussion regarding whether there was a need for executive session, the Board concluded that it was unnecessary at this time.
