**Minutes of the State Panel Meeting  
Held on May 10, 2016**

**I. OPENING OF MEETING 11:30 P.M.— at 160 N LaSalle Street, S-401, Chicago, IL**

**II. PRESENT**

John Hartnett, Chairman; Michael Coli, Member of the Board; John Samolis, Member of the Board; Keith Snyder, Member of the Board; Albert Washington, Member of the Board; Melissa Mlynski, Executive Director; Kathryn Zeledon Nelson, General Counsel; Sarah Kerley, Deputy General Counsel Anna Hamburg-Gal, Associate General Counsel; and staff members.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD April 12, 2016**

Chairman Hartnett called for approval of the minutes of the April 12, 2016, meeting. Member Washington moved to approve the minutes. Member Snyder seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

Chairman Hartnett asked Executive Director Mlynski to present the Executive Director's report. She presented the report and summarized the highlights.

**V. BOARD ACTIONS**

1. **Case No. S-CA-15-116  
American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31/City of East Moline**

Chairman Hartnett asked General Counsel Nelson to call and present the case. General Counsel Nelson stated that Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Sarah Kerley issued a Recommended Decision and Order (RDO) concluding that the Employer failed to bargain in good faith. After discussion of the exceptions to the RDO, Member Samolis moved to accept the RDO with modification. Member Washington seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously by a voice vote.

2. **Case No. S-CA-16-006  
American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31/State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services**

Chairman Hartnett asked General Counsel Nelson to call and present the case. General Counsel Nelson stated that ALJ Sarah Kerley issued a RDO alleging that the Respondent engaged in unfair labor practices within the meaning of Sections 10(a)(4) of the Act. She then summarized the issues presented by the exceptions, cross-exceptions and responses that were filed. After her presentation, she recommended that the Board accept the RDO. After discussion, Member Coli moved to accept the RDO. Member Washington seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously by a voice vote.

**VI. ADJOURNMENT**

Chairman Hartnett called for a motion to adjourn. Member Coli moved to adjourn the meeting, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.
