**Minutes of the State Panel Meeting

**I. OPENING OF MEETING 10:00 A.M.— 160 N. LaSalle Street, Room S-401, Chicago, IL**

**II. PRESENT**

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD September 11, 2018**

Chairman Hartnett called for approval of the minutes of the September 11, 2018 meeting. Member Samolis moved to approve the minutes. Member Snyder seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

**IV. REVIEW OF PROPOSED WRITTEN DECISIONS AND ORDERS**

1. Case No. S-CB-18-023  
**George Pruitt, III and American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Samolis made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Snyder seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

2. Case No. S-CA-16-133  
**Travis Koester and County of Sangamon and Sheriff of Sangamon County**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Snyder made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Samolis seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote. Member Glynn abstained from participating in this decision due to his absence at the September meeting.

3. Case No. S-CA-18-074  
**Policemen's Benevolent Labor Committee and City of Decatur**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Samolis made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Snyder seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote. Member Glynn abstained from participating in this decision due to his absence at the September meeting.

4. Case No. S-CA-18-085  
**Policemen's Benevolent Labor Committee and City of Sparta**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Samolis made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Snyder seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote. Member Glynn abstained from participating in this decision due to his absence at the September meeting.

5. Case No. S-CA-18-104  
**Diane Norwood and State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services (Human Services, John J. Madden Center)**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Samolis made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Snyder seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote. Member Glynn abstained from participating in this decision due to his absence at the September meeting.

## V. BOARD ACTIONS

### 1. Case No. S-RC-17-003

#### **Int'l Association of Firefighters, Local 2391, AFL-CIO, CLC and Village of River Forest**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Samolis moved to accept in part and reject in part the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. Member Glynn seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

### 2. Case No. S-UC-17-067

#### **State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services and American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Samolis moved to accept the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. Member Glynn seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

### 3. Case No. S-CA-17-060

#### **American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31 and State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services**

General Counsel Kim recused herself from this case and asked Executive Director Stevens to present the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Samolis moved to accept the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. Member Glynn seconded the motion. The motion passed with three ayes and one nay; Member Snyder dissented.

### 4. Case No. S-CA-17-001

#### **Illinois Council of Police and City of Venice**

General Counsel Kim called the case and noted that no party filed exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. The Board declined to review the decision on its own motion.

### 5. Case No. S-CA-17-049

#### **State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services and American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31**

General Counsel Kim called the case and noted that no party filed exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. The Board declined to review the decision on its own motion.

### 6. Case No. S-CA-16-006-C

#### **American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31 and State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services**

General Counsel Kim recused herself from this case and asked Executive Director Stevens to present the Motion that was filed to the Board. After discussion, Member Samolis moved to grant the Motion and ask the Attorney General's office to intervene. Member Snyder seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

## VI. EXECUTIVE SESSION

After a short discussion regarding whether there was a need for executive session, the Board concluded it was unnecessary.
